

"Community Service Award"

The purpose of this award is to promote social and community involvement by member schools. It is presented to the school which best exemplifies the leadership and dedication needed in solving community problems.

Selection Process and Criteria:

All projects for which a school is nominated must have occurred within the past 18 months. Schools nominated will be reviewed by the Awards Committee and rated for: Innovation; Student or staff involvement/teamwork, and positive impact and outcomes for the community.

Nomination Criteria

1. Outline, with supporting documentation, the school's single most outstanding community service project or an ongoing program under a specified theme.
2. Outline, with supporting documentation, how the school has demonstrated leadership and dedication toward solving a community problem.
3. Supporting letters from school or community leaders, public officials, etc. in support of the nomination.
